

**Manitoba College of Social Workers
Continuing Competence Program
Compliance Resolution Policy**

1. Where a practising social worker fails to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence program, the registrar may, at the registrar's discretion, provide notice to the social worker that the social worker has 60 days from the date the notice is sent to comply with the requirements.
2. Where a practising social worker fails to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence program, the practising social worker's registration may, upon renewal, be subject to a formal condition that the requirements must be fulfilled within 60 days following the issuance of the renewal.
3. A member who fails to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence program at the expiration of a 60-day period referred to in paragraph 1 or 2 above will be subject to cancellation of registration. Any applicable fees will not be reimbursed.
4. A social worker whose registration has been cancelled due to failure to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence program is eligible to apply for reinstatement within 3 months of the date of cancellation provided that he or she:
 - Is able to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of the continuing competence program
 - Pays reinstatement fee as outlined in the MCSW Fee Schedule
5. A social worker whose registration has been cancelled due to failure to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence program is eligible to reapply for registration after the 3 month reinstatement period provided that he or she:
 - Is able to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of the continuing competence program
