Although the Manitoba College of Social Workers does not have a language proficiency requirement for registration, most employers require social workers to have significant English language proficiency. Most social work positions in Manitoba require advanced oral and written English language ability, consistent with Canadian Language Benchmarking Levels 9 – 12.
