

REGISTRATION APPEAL INFORMATION

If your application for registration is not approved, or it is approved with one or more conditions, you have the right to appeal.

All applications are evaluated in accordance with the requirements and conditions under *The Social Work Profession Act* (SWPA) and *The Social Work Profession Regulation* (the Regulation).

Applicants must satisfy the registrar that their past and present conduct affords reasonable ground to believe that they will engage in professional practice safely, competently and ethically. [Section 4(2)(a), Regulation]

ALL APPLICANTS

The general application requirements that apply to all applicants are sections 10 of SWPA and sections 4 and 10 of the Regulation.

INTERNATIONALLY EDUCATED APPLICANTS

Section 7 of the Regulation applies to internationally educated applicants.

APPLICANTS SEEKING TEMPORARY MEMBERSHIP

Section 8 of the Regulation applies to applicants to the temporary category of membership.

APPLICANTS WITHOUT A SOCIAL WORK DEGREE

Requirements for applicants without a social work degree are included in Section 11 of the SWPA and sections 5 and 6 of the Regulation.

Applicants not approved for registration will receive a letter from the College explaining the reasons for the decision. The letter will also inform you that you can appeal the decision to the College's Board of Directors within 30 days of receipt of the letter. You will be invited to contact the Manager of Registration and Professional Practice with any questions.
