Below is an overview of the registration process for becoming a member of the Manitoba College of Social Workers (MCSW). Only registered members of MCSW can use the title “Social Worker,” or the initials “RSW” after his/her name. This overview is provided as a guide. Note: Timelines are estimated. All fees are listed in Canadian dollars. Fees are estimates and do not include costs associated with travel, meeting documentation criteria, etc.

Timeline	Tasks	Fees	Details
Step 1: Application for Evaluation of Foreign Social Work Credentials			
4 – 5 weeks after all documents are received. Documents must be in French or English	a) Complete an academic credentials evaluation from the Canadian Association of Social Workers (CASW)	\$339 + translation fee if required	
Step 2: Registration (MCSW) – if CASW determines your degree is equivalent to a Canadian Social Work degree			
1 - 6 months An extension may be required and provided for more complex applications	a) Complete the MCSW online application for “Applicants with a Social Work Degree”		
	b) Include the processing fee	\$100 + translation fee if required	
	c) Attach the required documents		
	d) MCSW will assess your application. If all requirements are met, your registration will be accepted and you will be issued Certificate of Registration.		
	e) Pay the annual registration fee	\$360 (prorated after May 1)
