

Manitoba College of Social Workers Continuing Competence Program Compliance Resolution Policy

- 1. The registrar may initiate a review of continuing competency program compliance in the context of an individualized or group practice audit at any reasonable time.
- 2. Where a member fails to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence program, the registrar may, at the registrar's discretion, provide an extension to the member to comply with the requirements within a maximum of 90 days.
- 3. Where a member fails to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence program, the member's registration may, upon renewal, be subject to a formal condition that the requirements must be fulfilled by the date determined by the registrar.
- 4. A member who fails to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence by the date determined by the registrar will be subject to cancellation of registration. Any applicable fees will not be reimbursed.
- 5. A member whose registration is cancelled due to failure to comply with the requirements of the continuing competence program following an extension is not eligible for reinstatement but may choose to reapply for registration.
